- Entry just £2 per map (£1 for juniors). Entry on the day only. But please pre-book a map in advance by email. Details below
- Registration from 18:15 to 19:00
- Mass start at 19:15 prompt
- Choose your own course - 60 mins or 90 mins time limit
- Penalty points deducted if time limit is exceeded
- Controls can be visited in any order
- Map and control descriptions will be provided (both printed on waterproof paper!)
- You need to bring a pen / pencil to record control “codes”
- A compass may be useful
- Dress sensibly in accordance with weather conditions. You will be in the hills.
- You must stick to public rights of way
- You can run solo or as a pair
- Under 16s welcome with parental permission. It is recommended that under 16s run in a pair
- Winner is runner collecting most points within allocated time
- Series results will be calculated based on your best 3 results from the 5 events. You must run in at least 3 to qualify
- Please share transport if possible and park sensibly as directed
